Prajwal, Varsha Lead The Pack

Bangalore: SD Prajwal of Sri Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain College and Varsha Ramachandran of Mount Carmel College led the boys and girls tables as the Karnataka state tenpin bowling championship (Under-21) got off to a splendid start at the Starcity Bowling Centre on Thursday.

At the end of Round 1, Prajwal had a total pinfall of 382 with an average of 191 in two games, played on long oil conditions. Close on his heels, with a difference of just one pin, was Prathyek Satya Chauhan of Centre for Management Studies with total pinfall of 381 and an average of 190.5 in two games while Ruchit Jain of SBMJC was 3rd with a total of 374.

In the girls' category, Varsha led with a total pinfall of 239 in two games followed by Sahitya Aras (234) and Malvika Jagasia (212).

A total of 148 boys and 19 girls are participating in this 4-day event.
