A meeting of the Governing Council of the college was held on 13th January 2017. It was represented by the Principal of the College Prof. K M Mahesh, Dr. B T Venkatesh, Director, JGI, Dr. Nataraj S N, Member of Governing Council and a representative from Bangalore University Dr. Ramappa who is also an Academic Council Member of the University. Sri Sanjay of English Department also participated in the meeting as a representative of the teachers.

A number of issues pertaining to both academic and extra-curricular activities was discussed.


Firstly the focus was on the University examination results. Dr. B T Venkatesh suggested a number of measures to be taken to improve it. One suggestion was to evaluate the results based on the performance in individual subjects. He also drew the attention of the university official to results which were not processed.

In order to improve the quality of the results Dr. B T Venkatesh further suggested that the I & II year B.Com results needs to be objectively analysed and students who have scored distinction should be further motivated through a special coaching to improve further.

Dr. Ramappa suggested having more training camps for the improvement of the faculty in the form of seminars and workshops. Dr. Ramappa also raised the issue about value added programmes and suggested that the college should introduce them. More than academic programmes Dr. Ramappa also stressed the importance of instilling values in the students by taking the help of such organizations like Sri Ramakrishna Mission. He also felt that that students need to build their self-confidence and develop their emotional intelligence.

Dr. B T Vankatesh felt that the students need to be given project reports, which would make them aware of the intricacies of Banking, Insurance etc.,

The Principal of the college Prof. K M Mahesh presented the Budget of the Library and other extracurricular activities for the academic year 2016-2017. He also proposed a vote of thanks.
