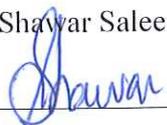

- The remaining 10 marks of the Internal Assessment shall be based on Attendance and Assignments /Skill Development Activities of 05 marks each.

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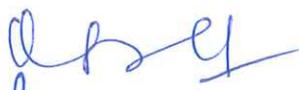

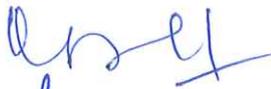
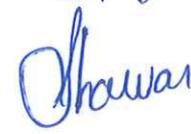
