



Archana bags three gold

BENGALURU, DHNS: Bengaluru's Archana Kamath churned out a brilliant performance, finishing with three gold medals in the South Asian Junior Table Tennis Championships in Maldives on Sunday.

Archana won gold in the junior girls' singles, doubles and team events.

In the singles final, Archana defeated compatriot Yashini Shivasankar 3-2 (6-11, 11-7, 11-8, 6-11, 11-9). Earlier, the Bengalurean had teamed up with Selena Deepthi to beat Sri Lanka 3-0 to win the doubles title.

The Indian girls' team comprising Archana, Yashini Shivasankar, Prapti Sen and Selena Deepthi Selvakumar defeated Maldives and Sri Lanka to clinch the yellow metal.
