

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Who is eligible for II PUC online classes?

Students who have passed in I PUC Board Examinations, and who have paid the II PUC admission fees are eligible for II PUC online classes.

2. Is it required to register for online classes?

Yes. It is mandatory to register for online classes. After paying II PUC admission fees, register for online classes on the college website providing the required details.

3. Are online classes compulsory or optional?

Online classes are compulsory. The first test syllabus portions will be completed online and the attendance taken will be considered for board exam eligibility.

4. When will regular classes in the college be conducted?

Keeping in view the recent notification of the Government of Karnataka, the closure of campuses shall continue till further notification. However, student engagement of the campuses will continue online.

5. I have failed in one or more subjects, what I have to do?

If you have failed in one or more subjects, there will be a supplementary examination in June/July. Prepare seriously by utilizing the available time. Once you pass those failed subjects, you are eligible for II PU admission for the academic year 2020-21.

6. If I don't pass in the supplementary exam, what are my options?

If you do not pass even in the supplementary examination, you will lose an academic year. You are not eligible for II PUC admissions.

7. I have failed in one or more subjects, but, I am confident of passing those subjects in supplementary examination. Can I avail the benefit of the online classes?

Students who are failed in one or more subjects are strictly not eligible to attend the online classes. But in the interest of student and parent, the college is giving the benefit of online classes provided an undertaking is to be given to the principal both by student and parent that 'you will pass the failed subjects in the supplementary examination and you are aware that as per the PUC Board, you are not eligible for II PUC admission for the academic year 2020-21.

8. When will I get the time table and schedule of classes?

Timetable and other details will be updated on www.jaincollege.ac.in website from time to time. Visit the website regularly to know the details.

9. Can I share my password with my other college friends?

As technology has its uses and abuses, it is strictly prohibited to share the individual's online class's credentials with others.

10. Are these online classes counted as regular attendance?

Yes. The online classes will be counted as regular attendance.
